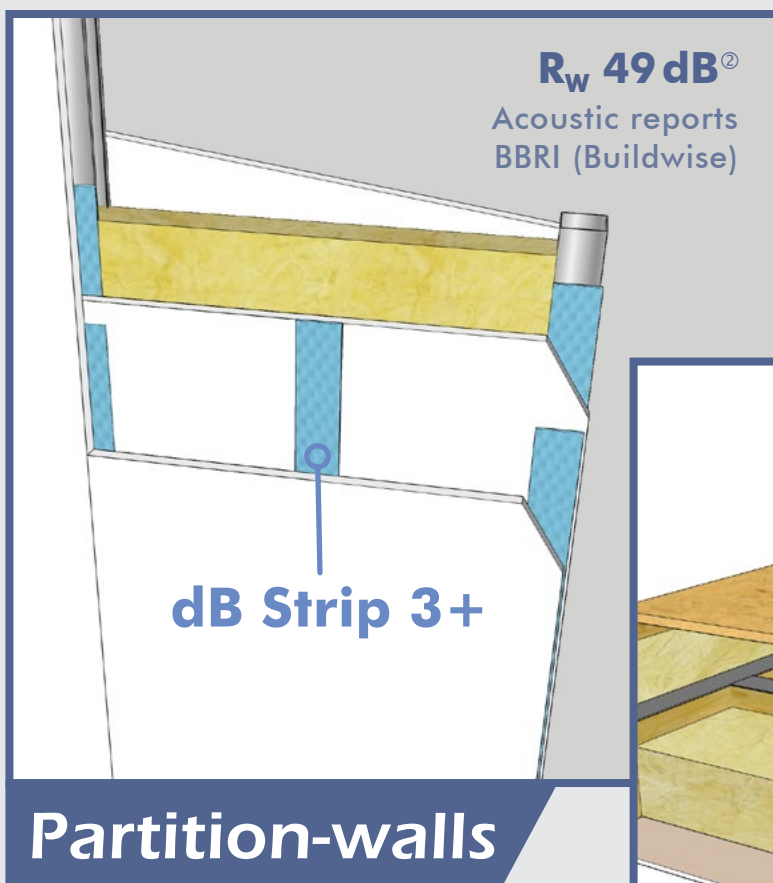

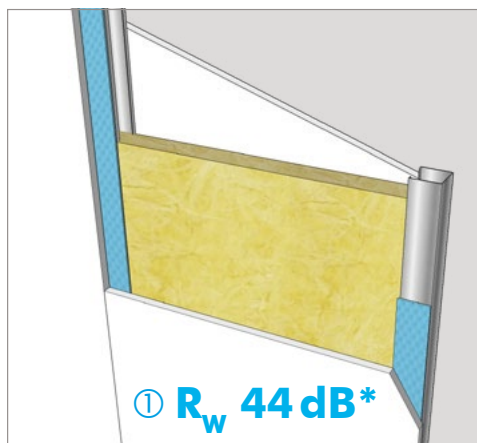

Uncoupling a light partition-wall

Setting 1 :

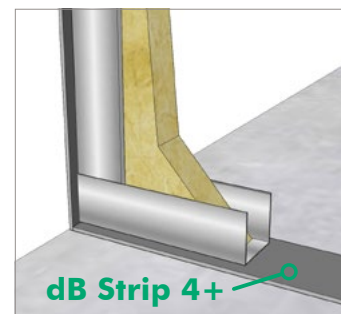
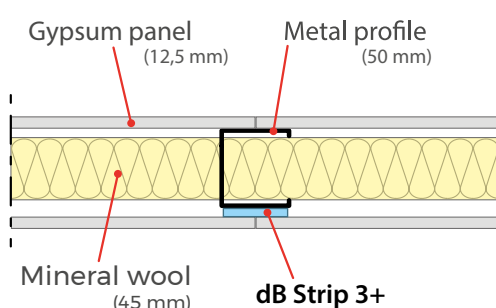

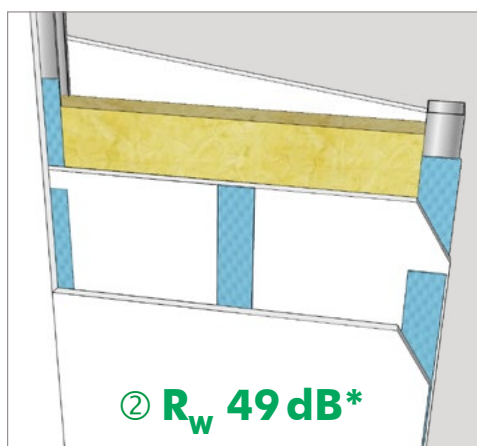
Stick the acoustic **dB Strip 4+** bands on the exterior side of the metal profiles coming on the counter walls, the ceilings, and the floor.

Once the partition structure is done, stick the **dB Strip 3+** bands on the side of the horizontal and after vertical profiles where the plaster boards are coming. Afterwards, screw the plaster boards (12.5 mm) on the insulated profiles and forecast a bond every 25 cm at 1 cm from the edge of the board with a specific self-drilling screw for plasterboards.

It is mandatory to use a depth gauge and to adapt the screwing speed on the driver-drill to avoid compressing too much the acoustic strips and to be sure to maintain their spring effect.



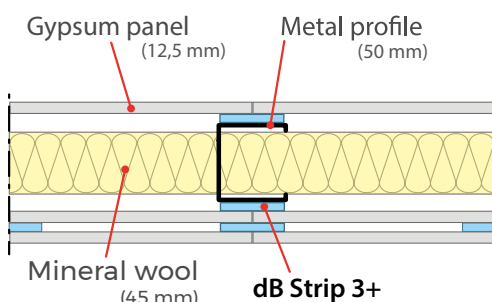
Setting 2 :



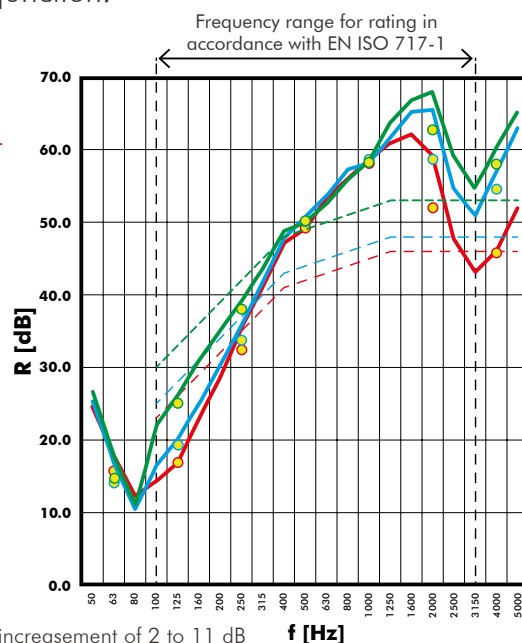
*② $R_w (C;C_{tr}) = 49 (-3;-10)$ dB

To enhance even more the performances, stick horizontally a **dB Strip 3+** band on the plaster boards on the top and bottom parts of the partition wall.

After, stick vertically every 30 cm the acoustic band. Finally, carefully apply the plaster boards (12.5 mm) on the vertical acoustic bands at every junction.

- Setting 2



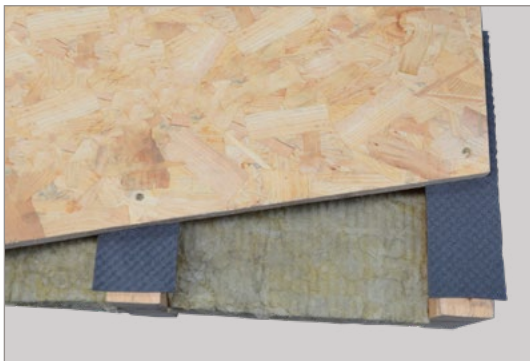
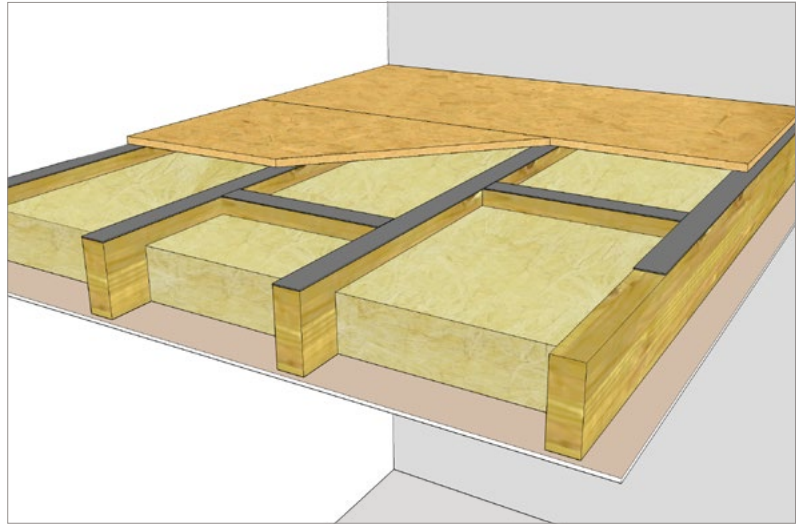
*dB Strip 3+ = An increment of 2 to 11 dB depending on the frequency

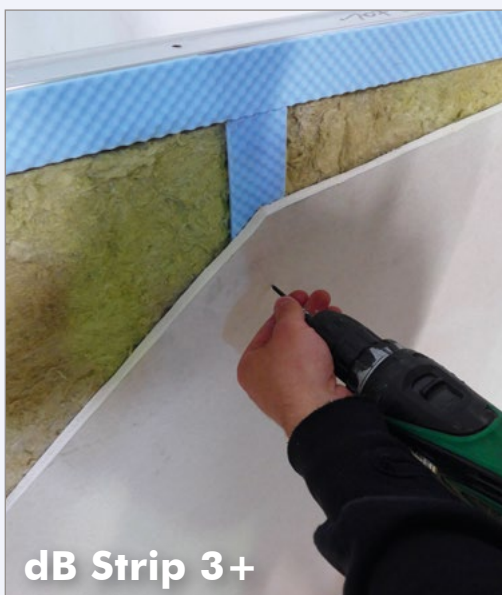
Uncoupling a wooden floor

The laying of the acoustic **dB Strip 4+** band allows to reduce the step noises between floors and mainly the creaking of wooden panels on the joists. dB Strip 4+ is specifically developed to resist against normal constraints of wooden floors. An efficient and inexpensive solution for a superior acoustic comfort.

Remove the protective film and stick the dB Strip 4+ resilient band on the joists before laying the new floor.

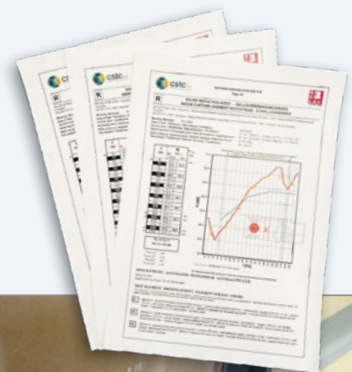


- Timber flooring

The only acoustic strip for partition walls with BBRI (Buildwise) reports.

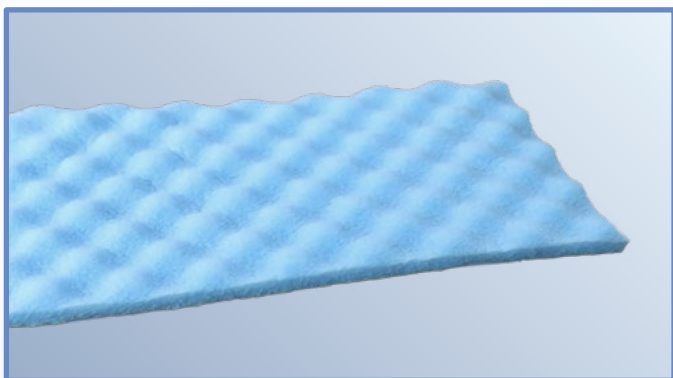


dB Strip 3+ / 4+

dB Strip 3+ and **dB Strip 4+** are physically crosslinked PE foam acoustic strips with a **pyramidal design** on one side and a protected **auto adhesive surface** on the other side.

These resilient strips were specifically studied to enhance the acoustic performances of partition walls and wooden floors, in accordance with the mass spring mass effect. Our dB Strip bands are inexpensive and easy to use.

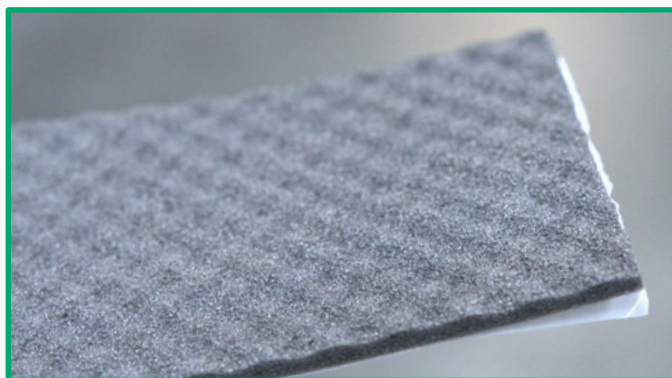
dB Strip 3+



dB Strip 3+ allows for light partition walls to achieve **comparable acoustic results than much more expensive solutions**.

dB Strip 3+ was tested by the BBRI (Buildwise) laboratory in different settings.

dB Strip 4+



Thanks to its width, thickness and higher density, **dB strip 4+** is more adapted to **uncouple wooden floors or the frames of partition walls**.
